The year 2020 has started off with a Spiritual Growth Campaign called "Transformed." We have been working on the Bible Study on Wednesday nights at 6pm and then I have delivered a message regarding that week's topic the following Sunday. I do hope you have been enjoying both the Bible Study and the messages. This will continue through the month of February. (Bible Study the first 3 Wednesdays and Messages all 4 Sundays.)

It is based on the Bible verse Romans 12:2: "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." We will have a series of 7 sermons and 7 Bible Studies on the following areas for "Transformed: How God Changes Us:" spiritual health, physical health, mental health, emotional health, relational health, financial health and your vocational health.

A phenomenal workbook will be made available for those who wish to use one to enhance their experience of "Transformed." It is great for small group study and daily devotionals. It includes memory verses, discovery questions, "putting it into practice," help for your prayer life and "diving deeper."

Transformation is about more than just putting information in your head. It is about living out what God is working in you. The Bible says "Be doers of the Word and not hearers only." (James 1:22)

Conforming means "to make or become the same" or "to behave in a conventional way by accepting without question the customs, traditions and prevailing opinions of others." In other words, to conform is to fit into somebody else's mold; it is to do things the way everybody else does. On the other hand, to transform means to "change the condition, function, nature, character or personality" of something.

CONFORMING has to do with Behavior.

TRANSFORMING has to do with Character.

CONFORMING is from the Outside In.

TRANSFORMING is from the Inside Out.

CONFORMING is something we do to ourselves.


TRANSFORMING is something God does to us.


#### WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE STUDY AND DINNER
