THANK GOD FOR HIS LOVE AND PROMISES

"O Lord, you are a great and awesome God! You always fulfill your covenant and keep your promises of unfailing love to those who love you and obey your commands." Daniel 9:4 (NLT)

There is nothing more important you can do during a crisis than pray. Daniel 9 gives us a great pattern for prayer as we walk through life's toughest times.

A RICK WARREN TEACHING...

...tells us to "let God speak to us before we speak to him; focus our attention on God and seek Him; express our desires with passion; and demonstrate our seriousness."

As stated above, "we must also thank God for His love and promises." This is described in the above-quoted scripture, Daniel 9:4.

"This may be the last thing you want to do during a crisis. You may be angry with God and frustrated with Him. But, that is why you need to do this. You need a change in your perspective."

Later in Daniel 9:9 (NLT) we read this: "The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against him."

"We should be grateful that God is faithful even when we are not. God keeps His promises every time. And God will continue keeping them in your crisis. He won't abandon you. Show God you realize that. Let Him know that you trust Him. It is an important part of a prayer that God will always answer during a crisis."

Our country is in the middle of multiple crises, but God is right in the middle of this with us. Remember that as you choose faith over fear.


- **G** Go to God in prayer daily. (John 15:7)

FIRES IN CALIFORNIA


